ALL SAINTS DAY-NOVEMBER 1: During the year the Church celebrates one by one the feasts of the saints. Today, she joins them all in one festival. The feast of All Saints should inspire us with tremendous hope. Among the saints in heaven are some whom we have known. All lived on earth lives like our own. They were baptized, marked with the sign of faith, they were faithful to Christ's teaching and they have gone before us to the heavenly home whence they call on us to follow them.

NOVEMBER AND THE HOLY SOULS: On **November 2nd**, **All Souls Day**, the Church prays for all those who, in the purifying suffering of purgatory await the day when they will be joined to the company of saints. We believe that there is a reality after death called purgatory, which involves purification from all sins before a soul can behold the face of God. The Holy Souls suffering in purgatory cannot help themselves — but we can help them! We can help them with our prayers, praying the Rosary but the most powerful prayer we can offer for them is the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass.
