**ST. MICHAEL, THE ARCHANGEL
Feast day-September 29th**

The name Michael signifies "Who is like to God?" and was the war cry of the good angels in the battle fought in heaven against satan and his followers. Holy Scriptures describes St. Michael as "one of the chief princes," and leader of the forces of heaven in their triumph over the powers of hell.

He has been especially honored and invoked as patron and protector by the Church from the time of the Apostles. St. Michael is the patron of grocers, mariners, paratroopers, police and sickness.

The Guardian Angels-October 2:

On October 2nd we honor the Guardian Angels. This feast affirms that there is indeed a spiritual dimension to creation and that through the ministry of angels, pure spirits composed of intellect and will, God communicates his gracious will and purpose and offers guidance and protection from harm, especially the harm that comes from sin. The angels can be true guardians and guides, assisting us on our journey to eternal life.

Pray often the prayer to your Guardian Angel:

O Angel of God, my guardian dear, to whom God's love commits me here. Ever this day be at my side, to light and guard, to rule and guide. Amen.

**MOST HOLY ROSARY OF THE VIRGIN MARY
OCTOBER 7**

The feast of Our Lady of the Rosary was instituted to honor Mary for the Christian victory over the Turks at Lepanto on October 7, 1571. The Rosary, or the Psalter of the Blessed Virgin Mary, is one of the best prayers to Mary, the Mother of God. In modern times successive popes have urged the faithful to pray the Rosary. It is a form of contemplative prayer, mental and vocal prayer, which brings down God's blessing on the Church. It is a biblically inspired prayer which is centered on meditation on the salvific mysteries of Christ in union with Mary, who was so closely associated with her Son in his redeeming activity.
