### 100 BELLS TO RING OUT ON REMEMBRANCE DAY

In 1918, the sound of the bells was the first time many Canadians understood that the First World War was ending. According to the Canadian War Museum, “the First World War was one of the most far-reaching and traumatic events in Canadian history.”

Canadians are familiar with the traditional two minutes of silence at 11 a.m. on Remembrance Day. This year, Remembrance Day will mark 100 years since bells rang with the **Bells of Peace Initiative**. As the sun sets on November 11th, Canadians will hear Bells of Peace ringing across the country. At St. Michael’s Parish we will participate with this Initiative and ring our church bells on November 11th at sunset.

### SAINT QUOTES ON HEAVEN

**St. Augustine:** “There, good will shall be so ordered in us that we shall have no other desire than to remain there eternally.”

**St. Philip Neri:** “If we only got to heaven, what a sweet and easy thing it will be there to be always saying with the angels and the saints, ‘Sanctus, sanctus, sanctus.’”

**St. Anselm of Canterbury:** “No one will have any other desire in heaven than what God wills; and the desire of one will be the desire of all; and the desire of all and of each one will also be the desire of God.”

**St. Bernadette Soubirous:** “My crown in heaven should shine with innocence and its flowers should be radiant as the sun. Sacrifices are the flowers Jesus and Mary chose.”

### RECOMMENDED WEBSITES:

**The Four Sections of Hell (St Thomas Aquinas) by Dr Taylor Marshall**

According to Saint Thomas Aquinas (*STh Supp q. 69, aa. 1-7*), Hell (Latin: *Infernus*) is divided into four sections or abodes:

1. Gehenna. This is hell in the strict sense, or the place of punishment for the damned, both demons or humans.
2. Limbo of the Children. (Latin: *limbus parvulorum*) Where those who die in original sin alone, and without personal mortal sin, enjoy natural beatitude without the sensation of pain.
3. Limbo of the Fathers. (Latin: *limbus patrum*) Where the souls of the Old Testament saints who died before Christ awaited their admission to heaven. Also called “Abraham’s bosom.” Also, a natural beatitude without the sensation of pain. Limbo of the Fathers is now vacant.
4. Purgatory. Where the righteous who die in venial sin or who still owe a debt of temporal punishment for sin, are cleansed by suffering before their admission to Heaven.




