## HOLY WEEK

Palm Sunday, we enter into the holiest days of the Church Year, the days in which we celebrate the completion of the mission for which our Lord Jesus was sent into the world: His suffering, dying and rising from the dead for our eternal salvation. Of all the weeks of the Church Year, during which God faithfully pours forth His grace upon us, we refer to one week only as Holy Week, because the source of all grace is found in the events which took place during this week.

Even as we call the truth that God became man for us the mystery of the Incarnation, so we call the truth that God Incarnate suffered and died for our salvation the mystery of the Redemption. The two mysteries are inseparably united. For that reason, St. Pope John Paul II was fond of referring to the two great mysteries together as one, the mystery of the Redemptive Incarnation.

Our 40 days of Lenten observance prepare us for Holy Week, so that we might enter as fully as possible into the celebration of the mystery of our Redemption. Through our participation in Holy Week, especially the Sacred Triduum — beginning with the Mass of the Lord's Supper and concluding with the Easter Vigil — we will draw closer to Christ and grow more gratefully conscious of His life within us through the outpouring of the Holy Spirit.

Is a very special Sunday when the Divine Floodgates from Heaven are wide-opened and Jesus offers us the total forgiveness of all sins and punishment to any soul, who goes to Confession and receives Him in Holy Communion. There will be a Divine Mercy Service at St. Michael's Parish on Sunday April 28th from 3:00 p.m. to 4:00 p.m., which will include confession. All are invited to come and benefit from his great feast.

**Introduction to the Devout Life by St. Francis de Sales.** Written over 400 years ago, Introduction to the Devout Life is still one of the most popular books for those pursuing holiness. St. Francis de Sales explains how to turn that desire for sanctity into resolutions that yield grace-filled results. Themes include:

- Pursuing a devout life whole-heartedly.
- Incorporating prayer and sacraments into a busy schedule.
- Growing in virtue
- Battling wisely against temptation
- Making spiritual progress through daily, monthly, and yearly exercises.

**The Dialogue of Saint Catherine of Siena**-Seraphic Virgin and Doctor of Unity. The works of St. Catherine of Siena rank among the classics of the Italian language, written in the beautiful Tuscan vernacular of the fourteenth century. Her writings consist of •the "Dialogue", or "Treatise on Divine Providence"; •a collection of nearly four hundred letters; and •a series of "Prayers".
