EASTER MESSAGE FROM FATHER MATTHEW

“Dear Parishioners: We find ourselves in the season of rejoicing! Christ is Risen! That very fact makes our whole faith, with all its practices and demands, worth it. If he has risen, forever breaking the power that sin and death held over us, then we can rise with him into Heavenly glory. No matter what hardships the world throws our way, Christ is our King, and our King is Risen! Today, more surely, and more passionately, than on any other day we echo the words that inspired Christians throughout the ages to bring about God’s Kingdom here on earth, submitting themselves to the sovereignty of Christ, and to look to the day when they will enter the eternal Kingdom prepared for us by Christ; Long live Christ the King!

Next weekend is **Divine Mercy Sunday (April 28)**. This unique feast of the Church is a day on which Christ has promised to pour out the full abundance of his mercy upon all those who come seeking it. Our Lord promised us through St. Faustina that, “Whomever approaches the Fountain of Life on this day will be granted complete forgiveness of sins and punishment (Diary, 300). Following upon that promise Pope JP II proclaimed that those who fulfill the requirements for the Divine Mercy Indulgence will receive full remission of the temporal punishment due to their forgiven sins.

The requirements to receive the Divine Mercy Indulgence are:

That they have the interior disposition of complete detachment from sin, even venial sin; that they have sacramentally confessed their sins (within 20 days before or after the day); that they receive the Holy Eucharist.
