THREE REASONS TO GO TO CONFESSION

1. A new beginning – No matter what you've done, you can find mercy and healing in the sacrament of penance. You will be sin free. Why would you not want that gift?
2. Concrete forgiveness - Our Lord does not keep us guessing about whether or not we are forgiven. When the priest utters the words of absolution, your soul is instantly and completely healed.
3. You receive graces - There is a mistaken notion that confession is just getting rid of our sins. But we not only have our sins taken away, we also receive graces from Christ that we desperately need to live a holy life. The more you go to confession, the more graces you receive.
