## MONTH OF THE HOLY SOULS



Each November the Church celebrates the Month of the Holy Souls. Beginning with All Saints day on November 1<sup>st</sup> and immediately followed by All Souls day on November 2<sup>nd</sup>, the Church calls us to remember the unity of the Church Triumphant in heaven, the Church Militant here on earth, and the Church Suffering in Purgatory. Throughout her history the Church has understood the importance of praying for the Holy Souls in purgatory, who by the nature of their condition, can no longer pray for themselves. Many great saints including St. Gertrude the Great, St. Padre Pio, and St. Catherine of Genoa, have taught extensively on purgatory. Enlightened by mystical experiences, they have profoundly deepened our understanding, and reiterated the Church's call to pray for the dead. While the Holy Souls are unable to pray for themselves, they are powerful intercessors for those who pray for them in this life. Many devotions and prayers are available to fulfill this Spiritual Work of Mercy.

Copies of prayers for the Holy Souls are available in the Church and on the Parish Website.

**During the Month of November, the faithful can gain a plenary indulgence for the souls in purgatory by visiting a cemetery and praying there for the dead.**

In order to obtain the indulgence, a Catholic in the state of grace must have the intention to obtain it and fulfill the following conditions:

- (a) visit a cemetery and pray there for the dead, even if only mentally
- (b) make a sacramental confession (a single confession, within about 20 days before or after, will suffice for all the indulgences a person obtains within that time period)
- (c) receive Holy Communion
- (d) recite at least one Our Father and one Hail Mary for the Holy Father
- (e) be free from attachment to all sin, including venial

**The Sacraments of First Reconciliation and First Eucharist:** There will be a meeting for parents who would like their children to receive the Sacraments of First Reconciliation and First Communion on Wednesday, November 18 at 7 p.m., at St. Michael's Church. You must register by sending an email to the contact listed in the bulletin.

**The Sacrament of Confirmation:** There will be a meeting for parents who would like their children to receive the Sacrament of Confirmation on Wednesday, November 11, at 7 p.m., here at St. Michael's Church. You must register by sending an email to the contact listed in the bulletin.

The candidate and at least one of his or her parents are expected to attend.
