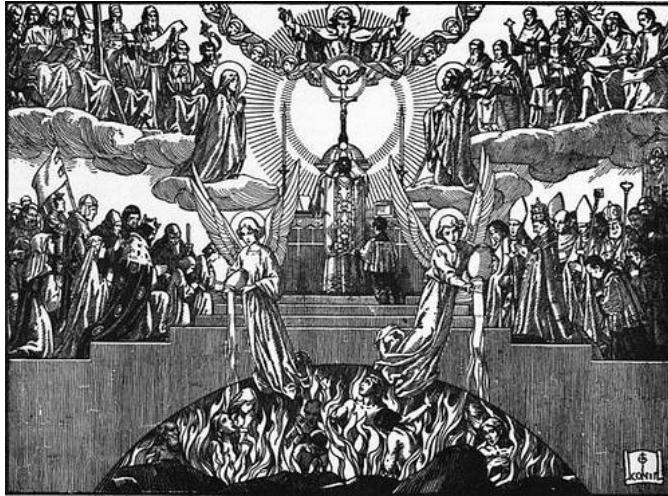

MONTH OF THE HOLY SOULS



Each November the Church celebrates the Month of the Holy Souls. Beginning with All Saints day on November 1st and immediately followed by All Souls day on November 2nd, the Church calls us to remember the unity of the Church Triumphant in heaven, the Church Militant here on earth, and the Church Suffering in Purgatory. Throughout her history the Church has understood the importance of praying for the Holy Souls in purgatory, who by the nature of their condition, can no longer pray for themselves. Many great saints including St. Gertrude the Great, St. Padre Pio, and St. Catherine of Genoa, have taught extensively on purgatory. Enlightened by mystical experiences, they have profoundly deepened our understanding, and reiterated the Church's call to pray for the dead. While the Holy Souls are unable to pray for themselves, they are powerful intercessors for those who pray for them in this life. Many devotions and prayers are available to fulfill this Spiritual Work of Mercy.
