### **Good Shepherd Sunday**

This fourth Sunday of the Easter is known as Good Shepherd Sunday because the Gospel reading invites us to reflect on Jesus as the Good Shepherd. In the Gospel, Jesus tells that those who follow him and his way will find abundant life. He identifies himself both as the shepherd and the gate. The shepherds who are faithful to him are the ones whom the sheep (Jesus' disciples) should follow. As this Sunday is also the World Day of Prayer for Vocations, we should be grateful for the shepherds who guide us in the footsteps of Christ. The Sacraments of the church will not continue to exist without our precious priests either. We should remember in our prayers all our priests, bishops and the pope, all brothers and sisters in religious life. They need all the support that we can give them. Please, pray for vocations to the priesthood and the religious life, for more devout men to hear the call to the priesthood and women to hear the call to the consecrated life.
