## September - month of Our Lady of Sorrows

"May I give you some advice for you to put into practice daily? When your heart makes you feel those low cravings, say slowly to the Immaculate Virgin: Look on me with compassion. Don't abandon me. Don't abandon me, my Mother! And recommend this prayer to others." – *Saint Josemaria Escriva*

### ***Catechism of The Catholic Church - "Faith"***

**1814** Faith is the theological virtue by which we believe in God and believe all that he has said and revealed to us, and that Holy Church proposes for our belief, because he is truth itself. By faith "man freely commits his entire self to God."<sup>78</sup> For this reason the believer seeks to know and do God's will. "The righteous shall live by faith." Living faith "work[s] through charity."<sup>79</sup>

**1815** The gift of faith remains in one who has not sinned against it.<sup>80</sup> But "faith apart from works is dead":<sup>81</sup> when it is deprived of hope and love, faith does not fully unite the believer to Christ and does not make him a living member of his Body.

**1816** The disciple of Christ must not only keep the faith and live on it, but also profess it, confidently bear witness to it, and spread it: "All however must be prepared to confess Christ before men and to follow him along the way of the Cross, amidst the persecutions which the Church never lacks."<sup>82</sup> Service of and witness to the faith are necessary for salvation: "So every one who acknowledges me before men, I also will acknowledge before my Father who is in heaven; but whoever denies me before men, I also will deny before my Father who is in heaven."<sup>83</sup>

### **Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament**

"Do you realize that Jesus is there in the tabernacle expressly for you – for you alone? He burns with the desire to come into your heart...don't listen to the demon, laugh at him, and go without fear to receive the Jesus of peace and love (...) Receive Communion often, very often... there you have the sole remedy, if you want to be cured. Jesus has not put this attraction in your heart for nothing..." – *St. Teresa of Lisieux*

### **Remember the importance of frequent Confession**

"Each one must confess his sin so that God's forgiveness, already granted on the Cross, may have an effect in his heart and in his life." - *Pope Benedict XVI* **Confession: every Saturday 3:30pm – 4:15pm and upon request.**
