#### Assistance needed with snow clearing and de-icing

Winter is coming! The parish is looking for volunteers who are willing to assist with clearing snow from the entrance of St. Michael's Church prior to Adoration, Masses, and Weddings and Funerals. Weddings and Funerals would require a 30min before Mass commitment to accommodate various needs.
