Remember the importance of frequent Confession

“Tell souls where they are to look for solace; that is, in the Tribunal of Mercy. There the greatest miracles take place [and] are incessantly repeated. To avail oneself of this miracle, it is not necessary to go on a great pilgrimage or to carry out some external ceremony; it suffices to come with faith to the feet of My representative and to reveal to him one's misery, and the miracle of Divine Mercy will be fully demonstrated. Were a soul like a decaying corpse so that from a human standpoint, there would be no [hope of] restoration and everything would already be lost, it is not so with God. The miracle of Divine Mercy restores that soul in full. Oh, how miserable are those who do not take advantage of the miracle of God's mercy! You will call out in vain, but it will be too late.” - *St. Faustina*.

Blessing Sundays

Every 2nd Sunday of the month there will be a Blessing Sunday – there will be opportunity to bring things (e.g. candles, crosses, images of Christ, statues and sacred ornaments, seeds, water, vine, olive oil, oats, herbs, cakes, cheese, butter, lard, bread, beer etc.) to the church and have them blessed after the Eucharist.

Assistance needed with snow clearing and de-icing

Winter is coming! The parish is looking for volunteers who are willing to assist with clearing snow from the entrance of St. Michael's Church prior to Adoration, Masses, and Weddings and Funerals. Volunteers would need to arrive at least 15min before each Adoration, hour and 20min before each Mass, shovel the snow and put down salt, as required. Weddings and Funerals would require a 30min before Mass commitment to accommodate various needs.
