First Friday overnight Adoration at St. Michael Church

Adoration will begin on Friday, February 4th, at 7 pm and continue through the night until 8 am on First Saturday, February 5th. First Saturday Mass will start at 8 am. There will not be Adoration after this Mass.

You are welcome to sign up for any hour of Adoration from 7pm on Friday until 8 am on Saturday. In addition to the "prayer hours" there will be a requirement to change out candles and monitor the safety of the burning candles throughout the night. Face coverings and 2-meter physical distancing still required. Please, sign in at the back of the church.


