Feast of St. Joseph – March 19th

"I wish I could persuade everyone to be devoted to the glorious Saint Joseph, for I have great experience of the blessings which he can obtain from God. I do not remember that I have ever asked anything of him which he has failed to grant. I am astonished at the great favors which God has bestowed on me through this blessed saint, and at the perils from which he has delivered me, both in body and in soul." (*Saint Teresa of Avila*)

Saint Joseph is a powerful patron. He is, as John Paul II called him, the Guardian of the Redeemer. He humbly accepted his role as guardian, husband and father in the Holy Family. St. Joseph's intercession has been sought for centuries. He is the patron saint of Canada. "In every difficulty apply to Saint Joseph with confidence and you will never be disappointed." (*Saint Mary MacKillop*) If you are going to pray the Novena to Saint Joseph, please, begin 9 days before the feast.

Blessing Sunday – March 13th

Every 2nd Sunday of the month (March 13th, 2022) there is an opportunity to bring things (e.g. candles, crosses, images of Christ, statues and sacred ornaments, chalk, seeds, water, vine, olive oil, oats, herbs, cakes, cheese, butter, lard, bread, beer etc.) to the church and have them blessed after the Eucharist.


