First Friday overnight Adoration at St. Michael Church, Adoration will begin on Friday, January 6, at 7pm and continue through the night until 8 am on First Saturday, January 7. First Saturday Mass will start at 8 am. There will not be Adoration after this Mass. You are welcome to sign up for any hour of Adoration from 7pm on Friday until 8am on Saturday. In addition to the "prayer hours" there will be a requirement to change out candles and monitor the safety of the burning candles throughout the night.
