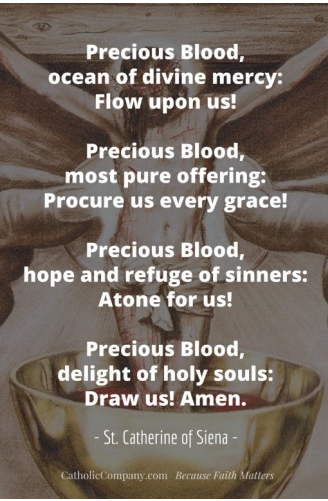

July- Month of The Precious Blood

From the time of the Passion, when Christ poured out His blood for our salvation, the faithful have practiced devotion to the Most Precious Blood of Jesus. In the month of July, the Church honors the Precious Blood and encourages us in this devotion. The traditional feast day devoted to the Precious Blood of Jesus Christ is July 1st.

The devotion has its scriptural roots in numerous references from the New Testament. In Romans 5:9, we read of justification by His blood. In Hebrews 10:19, we read of our sanctification and consecration by the Precious Blood. In 1 John 1:7 we are told that it cleanses us from all sin.

July 15- Feast of St. Bonaventure: St. Bonaventure was born in 1218 in Bagnorgio, Latium. His name at birth was John of Fidanza. He was the son of a doctor. When he was young, he suffered from a serious illness. His distraught mother took him to St. Francis of Assisi to ask for healing prayers. When healed, St. Francis exclaimed “O-Buono ventura!” (O good fortune!) From then on he was known as Bonaventure. St. Bonaventure studied philosophy and theology in Paris. He entered the [Franciscan](#) order in 1243 at age 22. He later became a bishop. Pope Sixtus V inscribed him Doctor of the church in 1557. St. Bonaventure was regarded as one of the greatest philosophers of the Middle Ages. St. Bonaventure wrote many books, including [The Journey of the Mind to God](#). He is known as the Seraphic (Angelic) Doctor.

July 16-The Feast of Our Lady of Mt. Carmel: It is on this day in about 1386 that Our Lady appeared to St. Simon Stock. She gave him a [Brown Scapular](#) saying, “Take, beloved son this scapular of thy order as a badge of my confraternity and for thee and all [Carmelites](#) a special sign of grace; whoever dies in this garment, will not suffer everlasting fire.” The scapular symbolizes Mary’s protection and reminds those wearing it of the call to prayer and penance. It stands for a commitment to follow Jesus and imitate Mary as the perfect model of all disciples of Christ.
