April – Month of The Blessed Sacrament



The month of April is dedicated to the Blessed Sacrament, the source and summit of our Christian life. Jesus Himself, body, blood, soul, and divinity, is present in the Sacred Host. In a tangible way, Jesus remains with us and is available to us, in our churches and tabernacles. What a great comfort and consolation amid our earthly journey, that we can have such assurance that He never leaves us. In this month, it is fitting to pray for increased faith in Jesus' presence in the Blessed Sacrament. Pray for a deeper love of Jesus and an understanding of His love for us, made known through this sacrament.

St. Ignatius of Loyola said of devotion to the Blessed Sacrament: “Jesus in the Tabernacle protects me against all my enemies, evil spirits, the world, my own wicked passions and evil inclinations. He is my support in weakness, my comfort in suffering, my weapon in combat, my refreshment in heat, food for my hungry soul, my stimulus when I am exhausted. He is my Heaven on earth.”

Divine Mercy Sunday – April 7

There will be Adoration and Confession from 3:00 – 4:00 PM at St. Michael’s on Divine Mercy Sunday. “A plenary indulgence, granted under the usual conditions (sacramental confession, Eucharistic communion and prayer for the intentions of Supreme Pontiff) to the faithful who, on the Second Sunday of Easter or Divine Mercy Sunday, in any church or chapel, in a spirit that is completely detached from the affection for a sin, even a venial sin, take part in the prayers and devotions held in honour of Divine Mercy, or who, in the presence of the Blessed Sacrament exposed or reserved in the tabernacle, recite the Our Father and the Creed, adding a devout prayer to the merciful Lord Jesus (e.g. Merciful Jesus, I trust in you!).” The Divine Mercy Novena begins on Good Friday.

Solemnity of the Annunciation of the Lord – April 8



The Solemnity of the Annunciation of the Lord is celebrated nine months before the Nativity of the Lord. The Annunciation recalls the day when the Archangel Gabriel appeared to Mary and revealed God’s will that she become the Mother of the Son of God, and she accepted. At that moment, the “Word became Flesh and dwelt among us” (John 1:14). The Annunciation is one of the single most important moments in the history of human salvation! It is an important Marian feast along with the Feast of the Assumption and the Feast of the Immaculate Conception. The date of this Solemnity is March 25, but in 2024 because it falls during Holy Week, the Annunciation is observed on Monday, April 8.
