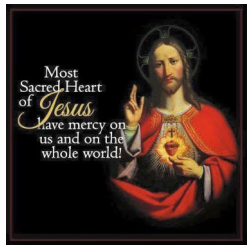

JUNE – THE MONTH OF THE SACRED HEART OF JESUS

In the Catholic Church, the month of June is dedicated to the Sacred Heart of Jesus. This great feast in the Church is always celebrated on the octave day of Corpus Christi, the feast which celebrates the Body and Blood of Christ. Corpus Christi falls on the Thursday after Trinity Sunday (which itself falls on the Sunday after Pentecost), which means the feast of the Sacred Heart falls nineteen days after Pentecost Sunday.

SOLEMNITY OF THE NATIVITY OF SAINT JOHN THE BAPTIST – JUNE 24

The Church celebrates the Solemnity of the Nativity of Saint John the Baptist on June 24th, and on the 29th of August, we will celebrate the memorial of his martyrdom. There is no other saint for whom the Church celebrates both of these moments.

SOLEMNITY OF SAINT PETER AND SAINT PAUL, APOSTLES – JUNE 29

Saint Peter: c. 1–c. 64 - Patron Saint of Rome, bakers, brickmakers, masons, bridge-builders, butchers, clockmakers, cobblers, fishermen, harvesters, watchmakers, locksmiths, netmakers, the papacy, and the Universal Church. Invoked against feet problems, fevers, and frenzy

Saint Paul: c. 3–c. 64 - Patron Saint of Rome, evangelists, theologians, musicians, public relations personnel, writers, publishers, and reporters; rope-, saddle-, and tentmakers; Gentiles; Cursillo movement; and Catholic Action. Invoked against snakes and hailstorms Pre-Congregation canonizations
