OCTOBER - THE MONTH OF OUR LADY OF THE ROSARY

The month of October is dedicated to Our Lady of the Rosary. The Rosary, a cherished devotion to Our Lady has been viewed not just as a spiritual exercise but also as a protective prayer in times of crisis. The most recognized incident linking the Rosary to divine intervention occurred in 1571 at the Battle of Lepanto. Pope Pius V urged all Catholics to pray the Marian prayer, imploring the Blessed Mother to protect vastly outnumbered Christian naval forces amid a battle between Muslim — a fleet of ships of the Ottoman Empire — and Christian navies. The Pope urged Catholics from neighboring villages to come together to pray the Rosary for victory.

And Mary Came to their aid!

We contemplate the power of the Rosary and the safety we find under Mary’s mantle.

FEAST OF SAINT SIMON AND SAINT JUDE - OCTOBER 28

Patron Saint of curriers, woodcutters, & tanners (Simon); hopeless causes and hospital workers (Jude) We honor what we know for certain of these two Apostles, that they were instrumental in the early Church.
